House of Horrors Rescue Update

On February 04, 2025, Sula supporters and dog lovers worldwide learned about the House of Horrors rescue. 26 abandoned and abused chihuahuas have been brought to safety and their healing journey has begun. 7 males, 14 females and 5 puppies have been transported to a quarantine area where new life unfolded. Some of the dogs have been more willing to come near people, feeling safe for the very first time in their lives. Others weary of the humans did not venture past their beds except to eat for a long time... Countless hours of sitting near the terrified souls, gentle touch, love and patience are the cure for horrendous "life" prior to the rescue. 3 chis are in the foster homes (one in Edmonton, AB, Canada), 9 still at the shelter. Please consider giving home to tiny survivor!
